Is that my hat?

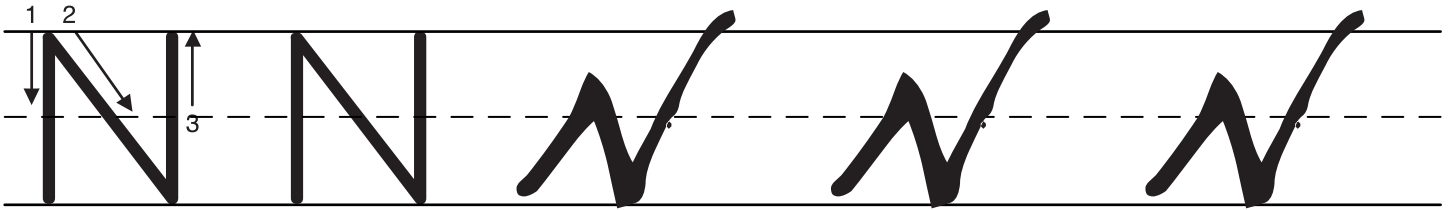
